ILLINOIS FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT

As per the Illinois Freedom of Information Act the Whiteside County Housing Authority (WCHA) is required to prominently display the following information:

2. A brief description about the Whiteside County Housing Authority- its purpose, budget and the number of employees: The Whiteside County Housing Authority originated in 1946. Our mission statement is to provide supportive services and housing opportunities, in an efficient manner, for the residents we serve. The Whiteside County Housing Authority manages 250 Public Housing units and 285 Housing Choice Vouchers. Our agency also manages an additional 87 tax credit units.

The WCHA has a five-member board and they formulate policies which are used to manage the day-to-day operations of the agency. There are 16 full-time personnel and 2 part-time personnel; which can vary during the year. The WCHA reports to and receives operating subsidy funds from the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development. The budget for WCHA has revenues with an estimated total of \$1,914,410 and estimated expenses totaling \$1,797,049.
